RE: Instructions for Individualized Language Development Plan

Dear Student,

Thank you for your interest in working independently to improve your English. Individual students and academic programs can create personalized language development programs for students who are unable to schedule regular language development courses in order to qualify for ITAP language reassessment. Be sure to find a qualified instructor to work with; one that is familiar with both ESL and pronunciation issues.

In order to truly benefit from the experience and be reassessed successfully, you will need to provide documentation of 45 hours of instruction and 90 hours of homework/individual language production practice. Because communication deficits only improve through time and diligent effort, coursework must be done consistently throughout the semester.

Individual language development plans must be discussed with an ITA staff and implemented by the end of the first week of the semester in which the student hopes to be reassessed. In order to qualify for ITAP language reassessment, documentation of completion needs to come from the academic program. You may use the following forms to compile your documentation.
